Maths

Place value: We will be working with numbers up to 100, recognising these, finding one more and one less and comparing groups of numbers. We will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Measurement: We will be measuring length, height, weight and volume. We will be estimating, predicting and explaining our answers using reasoning. We will count money and use coins in number problems.

Multiplication and division: We will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will be making equal groups through sharing and grouping. We will be adding equal groups. We will make arrays and making doubles.

Fractions: We will be finding and making halves and quarters of groups, objects and shapes.

Art and DT

We will learn how to weave using different materials.

We will be researching, designing and making our own beach huts.

Staying fit and healthy - We will be following daily exercise routines from Joe Wicks.

Dance- We shall be using 5-a-day to follow different dance work outs.

History

We will be learning about Brighton seaside and finding out how it has changed over the past 100 years.
